

# RIGHTS OF MEDICATIONS

## RIGHT PATIENT:

- > Patient's full name
- > Patient's full NRIC OR Date of birth
- 2 identifiers:
  - ↳ Asking patient verbally
  - ↳ Checking patient's wrist tag

## RIGHT TIME:

- > Frequency
- > Before or After food

## RIGHT MEDICATION

- > Correct drug/Fluids

## RIGHT DOSAGE

- > Amount of tablet, mLs based on dr's order.

## RIGHT ROUTE

- > Enteral → PO, Sublingual
- > Parenteral → IV, IM, IO, subq
- > Pulmonary → IH, IN
- > Topical → Skin, Mucous membrane

## RIGHT DURATION:

- > Given over a time  
Eg. 20mls over 1 minute

## RIGHT DOCUMENTATION

- > Record of given medications/Fluids

## RIGHT REASON

- > Medication is appropriate for patient's condition

## RIGHT RESPONSE

- > Monitor patient; Effectiveness, side effect and adverse effect

## RIGHT REFUSE

- > Patient's right to refuse

## RIGHT EDUCATION

- > Inform patient; why is it given & possible side effects
